

Severn River River Health Project

*GLENRAC has launched this new project in the Severn River catchment.
This 18-month project commences in January 2012.*

Funds for the project have been secured by GLENRAC through the Australian Government's Caring for our Country Program.

WHAT THE PROJECT INVOLVES:

Developing a River Plan for the Severn River by an independent contractor.

Providing 20 x grants to landholders in the catchment to make a positive impact on the Severn River system.

ELIGIBLE GRANTS include a wide variety of activities. This includes fencing off sections of the river, off stream watering points, weed control, perennial pastures, increasing groundcover + more.

Landholders will be encouraged to contribute to the grants, through their time, use of machinery and / or materials on hand.

LANDHOLDER AGREEMENT:

Landholders who are funded under the project will be required to sign a project management agreement with GLENRAC.

OTHER ASPECTS OF THE PROJECT:

Hosting workshops 2 educational workshops for landholders in Glen Innes area during 2012.

HOW TO PARTICIPATE?

Submit an Expression of Interest form to GLENRAC.

Applications will be assessed by a volunteer committee of landholders, along with Landcare staff.

WORKSHOPS FOR SEVERN CATCHMENT LANDHOLDERS:

A **HEALTHY SOILS WORKSHOP** will be held in Glen Innes 7th March 2012.

This one day workshop is usually \$200 per person, but will be offered for **\$20 per person**. Training will be provided by Resource Consulting Services.

The workshop will help you learn how to identify what contributes to healthy soils, how to monitor the health of soils + understand soil tests.

A **PROPERTY PLANNING + MONITORING WORKSHOP** will be held in Glen Innes

Wednesday 16th May 2012. This one-day workshop will be run by Resource Consulting Services (RCS) + costs **\$20 per person**.
