- b) Provision of stakes and cartons for planting
- c) Contract tree planting services to plant trees by Glen Industries
- d) Free loan of a Yeoman's moulder to assist in site preparation (October)
- e) Limited funding for the construction of stock proof fencing. This will be paid upon the completion of tree planting and fencing and a site visit by GLENRAC staff.

It will not include -

- a) Fencing materials
- b) Fence construction costs
- c) Supply of non-native or exotic seedlings
