What is the event about?

The NSW Rural Women's Gathering is an annual event hosted by a different NSW community every year. The Gathering is a well-established event with a large following; each event attracts between 200 and 400 women. The event is organised by a local committee, with the support of the NSW Rural Women's Network.

Where will the event be held?

The Gathering will be based at the historic Glen Innes Showgrounds, and will include educational and interactive field trips to a number of interesting sites in the local area. Some examples include Rangers Valley cattle station, a local history tour, and local gardens.

How do I register?

Registrations will be open in July, and will be done through the online booking site, Eventbrite. The information and web address will be available through The Country Web and the GLENRAC website. The Gathering committee is focussing on bringing women from the region together, as well as those from afar. Attendees are encouraged to bring a friend or relative, and there will be discount for mother and daughter bookings.

Who is GLENRAC?

GLENRAC (Glen Innes Natural Resources Advisory Committee) is the local Landcare network, and have partnered with the Gathering committee to bring the event to Glen Innes.

What is on the programme?

The full programme will be released soon, but some of the presenters featured are inspirational speaker Michael Crossland; television personality Effie (Mary Coustas); Gail and Roger Fletcher from Fletcher's International Exports; Georgina Dent, from Women's Agenda; and Jean Kittson, author, comedian, and performer. These speakers will engage, inform, and entertain the attendees, with their stories and the lessons they have learnt.

Why should I attend?

Women's Gatherings are known for being great occasions to learn, network, and socialise. This year's programme has been designed to showcase local rural and business enterprises, to motivate and stimulate women, and to focus on current rural issues. The Gather in the Glen team is committed to hosting a weekend that is inspirational, and is rich in educational, cultural, and social opportunities.
