3. Build community capacity to cope now and in future droughts

Gather in the Glen meets these requirements by providing the opportunity to learn, network, and socialise with women from all over New South Wales, plus some interstate travellers. By providing free places at the event, FRRR is supporting rural women to better cope with tough times.

To be eligible for a free registration, you need to reside in one of the following NSW local government areas: Tenterfield Shire Council, Uralla Shire Council, Glen Innes Severn Council, Inverell Shire Council, Brewarrina, Armidale Dumaresq Council, Walcha Council, Walgett, Guyra Shire Council.
