New Funding

Funding for Tree Planting Spring 2012

GLENRAC has received funding from the Australian Government to plant 10,000 seedlings in Spring 2012. This funding has just been announced. Application forms will be available at the Glen Innes Show display and on the website from 14th Feb. Applications will close 24th Feb. to enable use to secure seedlings from local nurseries.

Small Grants for Small Rural Communities Program

The Small Grants for Small Rural Communities is a collaborative program supported by various partners.

The program will offer up to \$400,000 per round in grants up to \$5,000 for projects and activities that offer

clear public benefit for communities, with populations of 10,000 or less, living in small rural and remote locations in Australia, contributing to their development in social and community welfare, economic, environmental, health, education or cultural areas.

The program is open twice a year, with closing dates of **31 March** and 30 September.

Funding for Flood Damage ~ January 2011

Don't forget to apply for flood damage funding if you are eligible. Landholders from Tenterfield, Glen Innes & Inverell districts are invited to submit an **Expression of Interest** as the first stage of applying for funding under this program.
