Get up to \$2000 to help your business be smarter and safer.

Who can claim? Sheep and beef cattle farmers in NSW – you can claim up to \$2000 if you are a sole trader or employ 50 or fewer employees, and sheep or beef cattle farming is your main business.

How do I claim?

Step 1 – Select and implement an eligible safety solution.

Step 2 – Complete and sign the application form.

Step 3 – Send your application form, with a paid tax invoice or receipt, to WorkCover NSW.

Up to \$30,000 for the installation of water infrastructure for livestock.
