GLENRAC receives new funding

The 2012-13 Community Action Grants funding have been announced last week and includes \$1,776,120 for 106 projects in New South Wales. GLENRAC has been successful in securing funding for three projects totalling \$55,200.

These projects are to map revegetation planting in the Glen Innes district \$19,500, Pasture to Pocket training for young farmers \$16,300 and Community action to protect a regionally significant wildlife corridor Year 2 (Rummerys Hill Landcare) \$19,400.
