CALCULATE THE CARBON EMISSION FOR YOUR FARM BUSINESS



What the workshop includes:

The workshop will feature a mix of learning and practical activities and you will also learn how to interpret a carbon account and consider options to address emissions for the future.

The carbon account will set a benchmark to show progress over time and can be used in on-farm decision making.

We will be using the University of Melbourne's Farm Greenhouse Accounting Framework Tools for sheep and beef producers. This is a free tool you can continue to use after the workshop.



Pre-workshop data collection will be required for each farm business. Depending on the size of your business and level of complexity this will take approx. 2 to 8 hours.

Your data will remain private, unless you discuss it with the group.



Data you will need:

Stock on hand

Weaning / turn off rates

Liveweight gains

Classes of livestock

Input and outputs such as fuel, fertiliser & fodder
